1. SUMMARY:

- a. SPC Derek Iannelli-Smith should be released from the support obligation of Army Regulation (AR) 608-99. He is currently paying BAQ-WITH to his wife.
- b. According to AR 608-99, paragraph 2-11(b)(3), a battalion commander may release a soldier from the regulatory support requirement if the income of the spouse exceeds the military pay of the soldier. In paragraph 2-10(b)(2), a soldier has the burden of producing documents that prove the spouse has a greater income. This burden is also met if an officer acting on behalf of the battalion commander attempts to obtain the information, and the spouse refuses to provide the documents. SPC Iannelli-Smith's wife has refused to answer two separate requests by the Inspector General's Office to provide records of her income. Since the necessary burden has been met, he should released from the regulatory support requirement.
- c. Finally, Mrs. Iannelli-Smith is currently living with another man in her parent's home. This reinforces the need to release him from the support requirement.

2. BACKGROUND:

- a. SPC Iannelli-Smith married Rebecca Devino on 4 August 1992, in Deerfield, Massachusetts. After eleven months of marriage, she left Fayetteville and returned to Massachusetts.
- b. He immediately began providing support to his wife on 14 July 1993 at the BAQ-WITH rate. He established an allotment so that the support payment would go directly to her bank account.
- c. On 18 January 1994, Mrs. Iannelli gave birth to their daughter, Samantha. In accordance with his duties as a husband and father, SPC Iannelli-Smith continued the support payments and increased them with each increase in pay. Despite the birth of their daughter, it is apparent that they cannot reconcile their differences.
- d. Therefore, SPC Iannelli-Smith has been attempting to obtain a divorce from his wife since September of 1993. First, he had a separation agreement prepared through the Fort Bragg Legal Assistance Office. His wife refused to sign the agreement. Next, he obtained a civilian attorney in Massachusetts and filed for divorce. His wife contested the divorce. Due to a lack of funds, he released the attorney in Massachusetts.
- e. On 4 August 1994, SPC Iannelli-Smith hired an , attorney in North Carolina to begin divorce proceedings. According to North Carolina law it is necessary for a couple to be separated for one year before a divorce can be initiated. He therefore began the divorce in North Carolina on 5 July 1995. Again, SPC Iannelli-Smith's wife used legal maneuvering to block the divorce from occurring in North Carolina. Due to ineffective counsel and a lack of funds, he chose not to proceed in the North Carolina courts.
- f. Despite the lack of success in obtaining a divorce, SPC Iannelli-Smith has been successful in acquiring visitation rights to see his daughter. Orders were initiated in Massachusetts which give him visitation rights during periods of leave from the military.

- g. He has also contacted the Department of Revenue, Child Support Enforcement of Massachusetts, in an effort to establish a financial support order for his child. Again, due to his wife's noncompliance, he has not been able to obtain a final court order.
- h. SPC Iannelli-Smith very much wants to be a part of his daughter's life. Since his daughter's birth, he has spent almost every period of leave traveling to Massachusetts. As a result, he has spent a considerable amount of money for travel and court appearances. Nonetheless, his wife has used every opportunity to prolong the divorce proceedings.
- 3. SPC IANNELLI-SMITH SHOULD BE RELEASED FROM THE SUPPORT REQUIREMENTS OF AR 608-99
 - (a) SPC Iannelli's Wife Allegedly Makes More Money:
- (1) As mentioned above, AR 608-99, paragraph 2-11(b)(3), provides a battalion commander the authority to release a soldier from the regulatory requirement of spousal support if the income of the spouse exceeds the military pay of the soldier.
- (2) Also, according to paragraph 2-10(b)(2), a soldier has the burden of coming forward with sufficient information and documents to establish a basis for a battalion commander's action under paragraph 2-11(b)(3). "This burden is also met if, in reply to a personal letter or telephone call from the battalion commander, or an officer acting in his or her behalf, the spouse refuses to provide the documents in his or her possession that may support or rebut the soldier's claim." AR 608-99, paragraph 2-10(b)(2).
- (3) SFC Frederick M. Hunter of the Inspector General's Office requested financial documentation on two occasions to establish the frequency, amount, receiving bank, and period that she has been receiving support payments (Enclosure 2). He did this with guidance from DFAS, so that SPC Iannelli-Smith could change his pay option from BAQ/WITH to BAQ/DIFF. SFC Hunter signed both letters which were sent to his wife's

attorney. SFC Hunter never received the requested information.

(4) SPC Iannelli-Smith's wife works full-time as a bank teller and lives with her parents. I contend that the regulatory burden was met when SFC Hunter attempted to establish his wife's income. She refused to provide documents in her possession that may support or rebut SPC Iannelli-Smith's claim. Therefore, I believe that Iannelli-Smith should be released from his requirement of spousal support.

(b) SPC Iannelli-Smith's Wife Has Committed Adultery:

- (1) While SPC Ianelli-Smith was on leave during 20 January 1996, he appeared in a Massachusetts court to contest his child visitation rights. The court granted visitation. However, his wife's attorney presented the court with a signed, notarized affidavit stating that, "Spouse, at the time of conception of joint party's child, engaged in sexual intercourse with a man other than her husband" (Enclosure 1).
- (2) This was a shock to SPC Iannelli-Smith. The issue of paternity never arose in the three years that he provided support and pursued divorce. He has submitted to a genetic marker test, and is currently waiting for the results.
- (3) Furthermore, while SPC Iannelli-Smith was on Jeave over 20 January 1996, he and another person witnessed his wife living with another man. His wife has lived with her parents since 14 July 1993. Mrs. Iannelli-Smith currently has a live-in boyfriend at her parent's home. She has also been seen wearing an engagement ring.

4. CONCLUSION:

I am impressed with SPC Ianelli-Smith's sincerity regarding this issue. He done everything possible to resolve this matter. I am sure that his wife is fully aware of the parameters of AR 608-99. It is my opinion that she has prolonged the divorce process in order to receive the BAQ-WITH amount as long as possible. This has been unfair

- 1. On behalf of the sponsor, SPC Derek R. Iannelli-Smith, SSN: 025-54-3236 we are officially notifying you of fraudulent usage of CHAMPUS benefits.
- 2. Per conversation with U.S. Army Judge Advocate General Attorney, CPT William J. Erle of XVIII Airborne Corps, Fort Bragg, NC 28307-5000, Ph. # 910-396-6113, he advised this sponsor to notify you of fraudulent usage of benefits officially.
- 3. Since 14 July 1993, sponsor and his spouse have been separated. Due to court litigation and time involved around this litigation, there is no official separation agreement or final divorce decree, which would complete the revocation of former spouses' military ID card and benefits. There is also a two(2) year old dependent involved, to whom is still entitled to receive benefits due to sponsors' active duty status.
- 4. Per conversation with CPT Hamilton of the Claims Office of the Judge Advocate General's office, a determination is consisting of the Department of Defense's involvement with investigation of the actual sums revolving around this fraudulent abuse of benefits.
- 5. Sponsor understands his commitment to pay these medically incurred bills and as annotated by enclosure 1(Consumer Counseling Credit Bill Consolidation Service), he has been making monthly payments on an unclear balance of these incurred expenses. The sponsor has not received any substantial amounts of claim checks in his name for more than \$30 that he can recall, to apply toward his ever-growing balance. All funds are coming straight out of sponsors' pocket. This is not fair to the soldier or the agencies involved who have agreed to the CHAMPUS supplements and have not received them.
- 6. Enclosure 2 is a signed statement by a Fort Bragg CHAMPUS representative outlining the facts of fraudulent use, and Enclosure 3 show's just one example of an endorsed check supposed to be applied toward these expenses. The sponsor has contacted above addressees both through mail and telephonic conversation and has not come to a finalization of this situation. Furthermore, Enclosure 4 is a formal revocation of powers of attorney for the sponsor's beneficiary that the sponsor sent through certified, registered mail to spouses' attorney.

Until the court drafts an official divorce decree, separation agreement or other legally binding documents, we would appreciate if the sponsor could have a little more participation on the delegation of these responsibilities rather than just picking up the full brunt of the expenses.

- 8. It is unclear why above-mentioned health care providers cannot file these claims themselves, but due to the state of affairs that this issue is currently in, we look forward to rectifying this issue now with the presentation of this memorandum and its enclosures.

On 3 October 1995, 1400 I came into your office, the Fort Bragg CHAMPUS office. It had come to my attention that I had been paying for medical expenses for the last year and a half solely out of my pocket. I was under the assumption that these bills that I was receiving from Community Health Plan were my left over percentage of what I owed for the medical bills for my ex-wife to whom I have been separated from for 2 years and 3 months, and the pediatric care for my 17 month old daughter. After showing Mrs. Posey all my paperwork, including bills, my payment to Consumer Counseling Credit Services to pay for these medical expenses, she assisted me in finding out more about the nature of my bills. After numerous phone calls and her efforts the below listing contains her notes on what she found:

06/06/94 - \$70.00 - allowed \$70.00 to dep. Pd patient \$34.56, CS \$8.64.

03/17/94 - \$65.00 - allowed \$34.50. Pd \$24.60, CS \$ 6.90.

08/23/94 - \$70.00 - allowed \$34.47. Pd \$27.58, CS \$ 6.89.

01/18 - 01/21/94 - \$1,603.46 - \$378.38 (100/0)

\$5,654.28 - \$2,627.28, CS \$27.90 (413) 772-0211

Hospital Bill, DOS 01-18/94 - 01/21-94

What this all means is that checks have been issued to the patient Rebecca Gwen Iannelli for the medical expenses accrued and to this date, none of the checks have been used in this manner. I have been paying for them every month through CCCS for the amount of \$40.00 dollars a month working on a balance (as of 09/26/95) of \$3,389.00. I vaguely recall Rebecca sending me CHAMPUS checks which were addressed to me and I endorsed and applied toward my balance with Community Health Plan: I have never received any checks for over \$30.00 that I can recall. As reflected by my payment to CHP every month, I have paid more than the checks were cut for. I am formally requesting Mrs. Posey to obtain for me a copy of the canceled checks so that I can verify how much, and how many checks have been endorsed and NOT applied to medical bills, i.e., Checks that Rebecca has cashed and not applied to what CHAMPUS has delegated them to be used for. Mrs. Posey has also helped to clear up some of the billing problems for me, requesting that all paperwork from now on be sent to me, instead of Rebecca when it comes to the payment of these medical bills. I am forever in her debt for helping me to rectify this astronomical financial situation. I vow also to keep Mrs. Posey apprised of this situation after all of her efforts on 03 Oct 95, and continue on with keeping my responsibility for paying for these medical bills for my dependants.




